D1/APR092025 / DEPARTURE MANILA – DUBAI – BOGOTA

INFLIGHT MEALS

Meet and greet in NAIA 3 at 2 o'clock in the afternoon, prepare for check in at 2pm, proceed to immigration and prepare for flight bound to Dubai to connect to Mexico.

D2/APR102025/BOGOTA – COLOMBIA ARRIVAL (D)

Arrival to Bogota and transfer to selected hotel. Check in and dinner at hotel. Overnight in: Bogota at selected hotel

D3/APR112025/FULL DAY GUATAVITA LAKE & ZIPAQYIRA SALT CATHEDRAL (B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Depart from Bogota and head north passing the towns of Tocancipá and Gachancipá, travel for approximately 1.5 hours until reaching the legendary Guatavita Lake. See hummingbirds, hawks, blackbirds flitting between the trees. The legend of El Dorado came about from Muisca traditions. When the Muisca elected a new cacique or chief he would be accompanied to the lake bathed first in honey and then in gold dust before being launched out into the lake on a raft with offerings of gold and precious stones to later throw them into the depths of the water. This ceremony and act of transformation created the legend known as El Dorado. Lunch at local restaurant.

After lunch, depart towards Zipaquira. After a journey of roughly 45 minutes reach the impressive Salt Cathedral, a true achievement of engineering. The name Zipaquira refers to Zipa, the leader of the Muisca tribe and the chief of these rich salt mines. The excursion will begin by visiting the cathedral in a tunnel that passes the fourteen Stations of the Cross and continues on to the dome. The dome is lit in such a way that it allows one to contemplate the universe and the relationship between man and nature. Later, reach the enormous cross carved into the saline rock and finally the three naves of the Cathedral that represent the birth, life and death of Christ. After the tour, transfer back to Bogota. Dinner at hotel. Overnight in Bogota Meals included.

D4/APR112025/BOGOTA -QUITO (ECUADOR) BY FLIGHT -HD QUITO TOUR (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel. At proper time transfer to the airport to take international flight to Quito. Tentative flight: **LA1441 BOG UIO 10H00-11H40–** Meet and Greet at the Airport, upon arrival outside of customs. Assistance and transfer to local restaurant to enjoy lunch. (Distance between Quito airport and the City 45 minutes approximately).

After lunch, you will have an ideal opportunity to visit the best handicraft shops in town, where you will find the finest selection of crafts from all over Ecuador. Quito offers a wide variety of art galleries that sell paintings, ceramics, and clothing inspired by the designs of the Ecuadorian Indian communities. The excursion also includes a visit to the artisan market, where artisans have gathered to display all their products. This is a good opportunity to shop for all the souvenirs. Then continue to your hotel for check in.

D5APR132025/FULLDAY QUITO COLONIAL, MIDDLE OF THE WORLD & TELEFERICO (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel. In the morning will start an excursion that offers the best of Quito with its rich cultural legacy, ornate facades, and dazzling gilt altars. Quito's Historical Center, the largest and best preserved in Latin America was built over the ruins of the Inca's northern imperial seat. A fabulous example of colonial architecture and art blended with indigenous styles. Quito, founded in 1534 became the first city in the world to be declared by UNESCO in 1978 a World Cultural Heritage site. The visit will take you to iconic places such as the Plaza Grande or Independence Square to have a view of important colonial buildings: The Archbishop's Palace, The Metropolitan Cathedral, The Government Palace, and a colonial Church and Convent.

From the Old Colonial Quito will travel north up to the station to take the Quito Cable car from which spectacular views over Quito's mountainous landscape are presented, hop aboard a cable car, one of the world's highest aerial lifts, that takes passengers on a 2.5km ride (10 minutes) up the flanks of Volcán Pichincha to the top of Cruz Loma. There will be some time free to enjoy the beautiful views (depending on the climate) of the city of Quito as well as of the mountain range that surrounds the city.

Lunch will be served at one of the local restaurants where you will have the opportunity to taste some of the Ecuadorian dishes.

After lunch a short trip to the north of the city of Quito will lead us to our planet's Latitude 0°0'0 to visit the original Equatorial monument and where visitors can learn about the 18th century French Geodesic expedition, one of the first executed under the modern scientific principles, which main's purpose was to measure the roundness of the Earth and then we will visit the Intiñan museum known as well as "The trek of Sun" where we will be guided through the wonderful world of the Andean Cosmo vision (view of the nature of the cosmos), Culture and Traditions. Mixed with didactic games where the physic laws show us the unique events that happen at the middle of the world. This is the place where you can stand with one foot on the northern hemisphere and the other one on the southern hemisphere...a unique experience. Dinner at local restaurant at walking distance from hotel with guide assistance 2 hours. Overnight in Quito at selected hotel. Meals included: Breakfast, lunch & dinner.

D6APR142025-QUITO – GALAPAGOS (BY FLIGHT) WITH ECOLOGICAL RESERVE (B/L/D)

Transfer from hotel to the airport in Quito to take the flight to the Galapagos Island. **Tentative flight: LA1415 UIO GYE GPS 09H16 – 11H48 –** Upon arrival at Baltra airport and after complying with arrival procedures: Ingala Migration Card (TCT card) and payment of the Entrance fee to the Galapagos National Park you will be met outside of the arrival lounge by the Expeditions

Tours representative to provide the transfer to Itabaca Channel (short ride of approximately 15 minutes). You will cross the channel by public ferry to Santa Cruz Island, where a car will be awaiting to take you to the highlands of Puerto Ayora Village to an Ecological Reserve, where you will be able to meet the giant tortoises in their natural habitat. After lunch will drive to hotel for check-in. Dinner set menu at local restaurant – walking distance Overnight in Santa Cruz Island Meals included Breakfast, lunch & dinner.

D7APR1525/GALAPAGOS

(B/L/D)

Breakfast. At the scheduled time passengers should be at the meeting point where the navigation excursion starts. Navigation will be offered to one of the following islands: Isabela, or San Cristobal, or Bartolome, or Plazas, or North Seymour, or Santa Fe or Pinzon.

**Navigation tour is provided on sharing basis and do not include transfers to/from hotel to dock or meeting point, due that distances are very short (5-8 minutes far away from the hotel). Our guide will contact passengers the night before to give you details and times for next day's excursion. If you require a transfer, please request it at an additional cost.*

BARTOLOME (BARTHOLOMEW) ISLAND

Famous for its Pinnacle Rock, which is one of the most representative geological and photogenic landmarks of the Galapagos and home of a colony of the Galapagos Penguins, one of the smallest species of penguin in the world and the only one found north of the Equator. The visit to Bartolome includes a climb to the highest point of the island for spectacular views of the surrounding lava scenery, an area often referred as the Galapagos "moonscape".

ISABELA ISLAND

Located to the west side of the Galapagos Islands, Isabela is the largest island of the Archipelago, the visit to this fascinating island includes: either Concha Perla Bay or Tintorerías Islet (according to availability at the moment of confirmation of program), the Interpretation Center and Flamingo's Lagoon. (Note: this visit includes transfers to and from Isabela island on board public boats; the boat ride takes approximately 2h30 each way)

PLAZA SUR (SOUTH PLAZA) ISLAND

One of the main characteristics of this island is its unusual fauna and vegetation which includes: a colony of Galapagos land iguanas found over parts of the small island; the Opuntia Cacti and the colorful Sesuvium plants. The sheer cliffs of the southern shore are an unparalleled bird observatory and the perfect habitat for

several sea-birds, including blue-footed boobies, pelicans, swallow-tailed gulls and the very colorful red-billed tropic birds.

SANTA FE (BARRINGTON) ISLAND

Santa Fe has one of the most beautiful bays of all the visitor sites in the Galapagos. It boasts a turquoise-color cove protected by a narrow peninsula that extends along the northern shore. The sandy beaches are often covered with colonies of Galapagos sea-lions. A marked rocky trail leads to the interior and cliffside areas where the Santa Fe endemic species of land iguana can be found within a very picturesque forest of Opuntia or prickly-pear Cacti.

SEYMOUR NORTE (NORTH SEYMOUR) ISLAND

Flatter than other islands, North Seymour is one of the few islands uplifted by underground seismic activity. This Island is one of the best places to see blue-footed boobies nesting on the flat rocky areas near the coast. Visitors will find one of the largest colonies of Magnificent Frigate birds. During the mating season, an explosion of bright red pouches inflated by male frigates to attract females provides some of the most spectacular sights in the Galapagos.

SAN CRISTOBAL ISLAND

A visit to San Cristobal includes: the Interpretation Center a place to learn about the natural history of the Islands; La Loberia, located 10 minutes from Puerto Baquerizo Moreno where a big colony of sea lions is usually lying on the beach; Cerro Tijeretas a small hill with a beautiful view of the islands and habitat of frigate birds; Punta Carola where visitors can observe marine birds, a big colony of sea lions and marine iguanas lying on the rocks.

(Note: this visit includes transfers to and from San Cristobal island on board public boats; the boat ride takes approximately 2h30 each way)

PINZON ISLAND

It is an uninhabited island with an area of 18 km² and a maximum altitude of 458 meters. It has no visitor or tourist sites, as it is mainly a diving or snorkeling site, offering opportunities to observe the beautiful wildlife and allowing to have a closer look of the marine life. Pinzon is home to giant tortoises, sea lions, marine iguanas, dolphins, eels, eagle rays, dolphins and even lobster, among other endemic species.

Dinner set menu at local restaurant – walking distance

Overnight in Santa Cruz island Meals included: Breakfast, lunch & dinner.

D8APR1625/ GALAPAGOS ISLANDS – QUITO (BY FLIGHT) (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel. At the scheduled time transfer from the hotel in Puerto Ayora to the airport located at Baltra Island to take the flight back to mainland Ecuador – Quito city ***Tentative flight: LA1410 GPS GYE UIO 12H45 – 17H05 –*** Upon arrival to Quito, transfer to hotel. Early dinner will be provided at local restaurant including transfers hotel-restaurant-hotel. Overnight in Quito, Meals included Breakfast & dinner

D9APR1725/FULL DAY COTOPAXI – QUITO -LIMA (BY FLIGHT) (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel. We will depart Quito due south going through the famous Avenue of the Volcanoes direction to the Cotopaxi National Park. The Park surrounds the imposing Cotopaxi Volcano, arguably one of the highest active volcanoes in the world is an almost perfect snow cone that raises with an altitude of 5897 m.a.s.l. which on clear days is visible even from Quito.

There are a variety of vegetation zones within the park; however, snow prevents the forming of flora high up the Cotopaxi volcano. The flat plains are covered with volcanic stones, that give evidence of the powerful relatively recent eruptions. Humid Mountain Forest dominates the low elevations, particularly around Lake Limpiopungo where will have the opportunity to hike and observe the paramo grasses, pajonal as well as mosses. This is an excellent place to rest and enjoy the landscape if you can't handle the altitude. The serene Lagoon of possible glacial

origin has clear cold waters and is surrounded by a magnificent view of elevations such as Cotopaxi, the Sincholagua (4.873 m) and Rumiñahui (4.721 m). In this area you can see a great variety of birds, llamas and if lucky rabbits and deer.

The excursion also includes the visit to the small museum located at 4.500 m.a.s.l. where we will find general information about the Park as well as about its wildlife. Needless to say, it is impossible to know if you will see Cotopaxi or not because of the weather changes which produce low clouds. But fortunately, there is no need to climb Cotopaxi or to fully see it to enjoy its beauty and the tranquility of the surrounding landscape.

Lunch is included in one of the local hosterias. After lunch, departure back to Quito, direct to the airport to connect to the international departure flight.

Tentative flight: LA2431 UIO LIM 20H05 22H20-

Arrival to the airport in Lima, reception, and transfer to the hotel. Dinner room service. Overnight in: Lima Meals included: Breakfast, lunch & box dinner

D10APR1825-HALF DAY LIMA TOUR (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel. Half-day panoramic city tour that begins at Miraflores, the perfect viewpoint to admire the beautiful vistas of the Pacific Ocean. From there, we'll proceed to downtown Lima, a UNESCO World Heritage site since 1991. This area was once the epicenter of Spanish rule in this part of the continent. During our tour, you'll marvel at the imposing architectural gems that have stood the test of time since colonial days, including the Main Square, the Cathedral (with entrance) and San Francisco Convent

Lunch set menu at restaurant “La Muralla” or similar

Finally, we will visit the Larco Museum, which houses the private collection of Mr. Rafael Larco Hoyle. Here, you'll be treated to an exceptional journey through 5,000 years of Peruvian history within the confines of a beautiful manor built atop an ancient pre-Inca site. The museum boasts a collection of over 45,000 ceramics and hundreds of textiles, metals, and stones. Additionally, you'll have exclusive access to its storeroom and the renowned collection of erotic pottery.

Dinner set menu at restaurant “Mangos Larcomar” or similar

Overnight in Lima Meals included: Breakfast, lunch & dinner.

D11APR1925/LIMA -CUSCO (BY FLIGHT) (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to Lima's airport to take your flight to Cusco.

Tentative flight: LA2017 LIM CUZ 08h40 10H00 –

Meeting service at airport with guide and private transfer to the local restaurant. Lunch at restaurant “Tunupa Cusco” or similar.

In the afternoon, start our tour by heading to Main Square Plaza de Armas, the Cathedral of Cusco and the Koricancha or Temple of the Sun where we will find one of the best samples of the skill of the Incas on stone. Then, our journey will take to the remarkable fortress of Sacsayhuaman, a true masterpiece of military architecture constructed from enormous stones meticulously cut and precisely assembled. We will also explore the Qenqo complex, featuring limestone rocks with underground galleries historically used for agricultural rituals. The tour will then lead to Tambomachay, known for its well-preserved structures and intricate water channels, often referred to as the "Bath of the Incas."

Transfer to Urubamba Sacred Valley. Dinner set menu at hotel. Overnight in Urubamba Meals included: Breakfast, lunch & dinner.

D12APR2025/FULL DAY SACRED VALLEY (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel. Proceed to visit Chincheros Town, the Salt Mines of Maras (only panoramic view) and Moray ruins. Lunch buffet at restaurant “Don Angel” or similar

In the afternoon, we will visit the Ollantaytambo Archaeological Site. Originally established by the Incas as a storehouse and resting point, it gained historical significance when Manco Inca sought refuge here and ordered its fortification. Of particular note is the impressive fortress built into the mountainside, which is believed to be the site of the legendary battle where the Incas successfully defended against the Spanish conquerors." Return to the hotel
Dinner set menu at hotel Overnight in: Sacred Valley at selected hotel
Meals included: Breakfast, lunch & dinner.

D13APR2125/SACRED VALLEY – MACHU PICCHU -CUSCO (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel. Transfer with guide to Ollantaytambo train station. Leave to Machu Picchu by Peru Rail Vistadome train (with guide on board). Arrival and transfer by local shuttle minibus to Machu Picchu citadel for a guided tour of the archaeological site. Machu Picchu is one of the last structures built by the Incas–mid XV century–where they show their skill in handling the stone. The citadel is located approximately 2,400 meters above sea level, and the huge rocks used in its construction were sourced from a nearby quarry. In the place, we can identify the different sectors, among the urban, religious and farming. Lunch at Tinkuy Restaurant at Belmond Sanctuary Lodge Hotel. Afterward descended by shuttle minibus returning to Aguas Calientes. Arrival Ollantaytambo train station and transfer to the hotel in Cusco city
Dinner set menu at restaurant “Artisano Regocijo” or similar
Overnight in Cusco Meals included Breakfast, lunch & dinner.

D14/APR2225- FULL DAY RAINBOW MOUNTAIN OR PALCOYO – CUSCO – LIMA (BY FLIGHT) (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel. We departed from the hotel very early this morning, taking the southeastern highway from Cusco. After driving approximately 80 kilometers to reach the Cusipata community, we made a left turn onto an unpaved road leading to the village of Llaqto, situated at an elevation of 4,640 meters above sea level. Here, we began a hike lasting approximately an hour and a half, ascending to Vinicunca or Palcoyo mountain. Lunch at local restaurant
Return to Cusco. Arrival Cusco, pick up suitcases at the hotel and transfer to restaurant. Dinner at local restaurant
After dinner, transfer to the airport in Cusco. ***Tentative flight: LA2030 CUZ LIM 21H00-22H30-***
Arrival to the airport in Lima, assistance to check in at airport hotel.
Overnight in Lima at airport hotel, Meals included: Breakfast, lunch & dinner.

D15/APR2325- LIMA-BUENOS AIRES (ARGENTINA) – BY FLIGHT- DINNER WITH TANGO SHOW (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel. Assistance at the airport to take flight to Buenos Aires. ***Tentative flight LA2380 LIM-AEP 09H35 16H00–*** Upon arrival to Buenos Aires transfer to the hotel. Rest of the afternoon at leisure. Dinner & Tango Show at Café de Los Angelitos
Without losing any of its original bohemian charm, the traditional corner of Rivadavia and Rincón dresses in all its finery to welcome one of the best tango shows in the city. Revamped in accordance with an ambitious architectural project, its 1,500 square metres consisting of two floors and a basement, display luxury and distinction even in the most insignificant details. Created in 1890 under the name of Bar Rivadavia, it soon became the meeting place for poets, musicians and improvising folk singers or 'payadores', who shared the tables with swindlers, thugs and pimps. The legend goes that the district police commissioner would ironically call the latter group 'little angels'. This nickname became so popular that some years later, in 1920, the place definitely received its current name. Every

night, 21 avant-garde artists on stage luxuriously recreate a whole tango age. And they write the first page of the next ages. Departing from the hotel at 8 PM towards the tango venue, the night begins with a 3-Course Dinner accompanied by fine Argentine wines and at 10 PM approximately begins an unforgettable Tango Show. The transfer back to the hotel is at around midnight.
Overnight in Buenos Aires , Meals included: Breakfast & dinner.

D16/APR2425-FULL DAY BUENOS AIRES CITY TOUR (B/L/D)

Visit to the Historical Complex of Plaza de Mayo (May Square) where we can see the Government House called: Casa Rosada (Pink House), site of the Argentine National Government, next to the Metropolitan Cathedral and the historical Cabildo, a beautiful 18th century building, site of the first Government born in our country. Our tour continues south, to the oldest quarters of the city. Arrival to La Boca district, largest typical Italian quarter, where a colony of artists made our city worldwide famous through their painting, sculpture, etc. Caminito is nowadays a painters market on Saturdays and Sundays. Afterwards, we pass by San Telmo, a paradise for antique lovers. On the way to the north we will see the new neighborhood of Puerto Madero, whose docks have been turned into the finest restaurants in the city. The trip continues to the North towards July 9th Avenue to see the famous Obelisk, the symbol of the city. Next highlight is La Recoleta Quarter, where French architectural influence will be admired: houses, apartments, shops, streets, cafes and restaurants, offering a lively and colorful picture. Here we will enjoy some free time to visit Our Lady of Pilar Church and the Northern Cemetery, with the tomb of Evita Perón. Passing by the Exposition Centre of the city, the Faculty of Law and the National Museum of Fine Arts we'll arrive to Palermo Chico, a neighborhood plenty of old-aristocratic residences which stand facing the Parks. This immense 2.500 acre Park, even not being the largest in the city, but the most beloved by citizens and tourists from all over the world.

Lunch and dinner at local restaurants. Overnight in: Buenos Aires , Meals included: Breakfast, lunch & dinner.

D17/APR2525-BUENOS AIRES -EL CALAFATE (BY FLIGHT) (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel. At the proper time transfer to the airport to take the domestic flight to El Calafate. ***Tentative flight AR1894 AEP FTE 11H00-14H20-***. Upon arrival to El Calafate, transfer to hotel to check in. rest of the day at leisure. At proper time, transfer to local restaurant to enjoy dinner Overnight in El Calafate Meals included: Breakfast, lunch & dinner.

D18/APR2625- FULL DAY PERITO MORENO & SAFARI NAUTICO (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel. We leave heading westwards to **Los Glaciares National Park, UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1981**. The most famous glacier is the so-called Perito Moreno, located on the Argentino Lake, in front of Magallanes Peninsula, 78 km away from town. It is 30 km long, its front is 5 km wide and it reaches a total area of 257 km2. Its name pays tribute to a great Argentine explorer of the 20th century. We will first cover a distance of 48 km through the Patagonian steppe, where we will see guanacos, rheas, hares and maybe condors, chimangos and crested caracaras. We will also see curious rock formations, such as the so-called Elephants, Sleeping Indian and Comisión Hills. After entering the National Park we will go through a transition area in which the landscape turns into a sub Andean Patagonian forest. We will see the Rico Arm of the Argentino Lake, surrounded by lengas, cipreses, ciruelillos, calafates and ñires. The Perito Moreno Glacier can already be seen at the so-called 'Sighs Curve', from where we will admire its wall of ice of up to 80 metres in height. Continuing to the balconies, we will be about 300 metres away from the front of the glacier. From there we will

have breathtaking views of it, appreciate the different shades of blue-coloured ice on its surface and hear the sounds of block of ice falling into the Icebergs Channel Nautical Safari (Shared navigation):

Departing from Bajo de las Sombras Pier, located 6 km before the balconies, you get on board a catamaran to navigate the Rico Arm of the Argentino Lake parallel to the southern wall of the Perito Moreno glacier and thus observing the deafening ice detachments from its front. Among icebergs, the catamaran navigates only 600 metres away from the glacier and covers its entire wall, which allows to appreciate the constant activity of the glacier, the diverse blue-coloured tones of its front and its detachments to the Rico Lake. This navigation offers a totally different perspective of the glacier and the surrounding mountains than that from the balconies, since from the catamaran it is possible to see the glacier's wall from the level of the lake's waters and to appreciate the colossal dimensions of this mass of ice and its icebergs. Once in front of the wall, the catamaran stops for a few minutes to observe the landscape as a whole. This is the ideal moment to take the best photos!

Lunch at Nativos de la Patagonia Restaurant- located within National Park. Dinner at hotel's restaurant. Overnight in: El Calafate Meals included: Breakfast, lunch & dinner.
