

**SOUTH AFRICA 'Let's Hunt the BIG 5' UPGRADED
CAPE TOWN - JOHANNESBURG - KRUGERPARK – KARONGWEI – ZIMBABWE
– JOHANNESBURG
SEPTEMBER 15-29, 2024**

DAY 01 : DAY01– MNL - AIRPORT (No Meal)
Meet at NAIA terminal 1, for debriefing and distribution of embarkation cards, proceed to check in and immigration and prepare for flight which connects **MNL-SIN - CPT**

DAY 02: MEET & GREET CITY TOURCAPE TOWN – CAMPS BAY (L/D)
Our staff will receive you at **Cape Town International Airport**. Depending on your arrival time we will do a City Tour which also serves as an introduction to the Mother City, pointing out Historical Landmarks, including the **city hall, Castle of Good Hope** and **Bo-kaap, shopping hot spots** and recommended restaurants. Proceed to your hotel for check in , freshen up , get ready for your dinner at V&A water front, return back to your hotel for dinner and overnight.
STAY AT : GARDEN COURT VICTORIA JUNCTION

DAY 03: CAPE POINT & PENINSULA TOURCAPE TOWN – SIMON'S TOWN – CAPE POINT (B/L/D)
After breakfast today we visit the **Atlantic Seaboard** to the **fishing harbour of Hout Bay** where you can stop to **take a boat trip to Duiker Island**, home to a colony of Cape Fur Seals. **Chapman's Peak Drive** leads through the **rural villages of Noordhoek, Oceanview, Kommetjie and Scarborough** to the entrance of the **Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve**. the landscape is rugged and it is no wonder that the Portuguese sea farers called the cape "Cabo Tormentoso", meaning the Cape of Storms. Visit the Cape of Good Hope, the most south-western tip of the African Continent. The **Old Lighthouse at Cape Point** The next stop is **Boulder's Beach Simonstown** where the **South African Naval Headquarters** The **seaside towns of Fishhoek** and **Muizenberg border** the False Bay you will have a lunch stop at the **Harbour House in KalkBay** before your coach drops you off at the hotel again for dinner and overnight

Day 04: TABLE MOUNTAIN & ROBBEN ISLAND TOUR CAPE TOWN AND WATERFRONT (B/L/D)
After Breakfast, we proceed to **Cape Town aerial cable car station lions head** and the City Centre
We combine two of Cape Town's most iconic landmarks in a Full Day experience that will be both spectacular and also emotional as well! When you **visit the cell that Nelson Mandela** lived in for 18 years of his 27-year incarceration, tears have been known to flow. The day is divided into two parts, **Table Mountain in the morning** and then **Robben Island in the afternoon**. This is because weather can be a factor, normally the conditions are more favorable for the mountain in the mornings. Lunch will be at the V & A Waterfront. After the tour proceed back to hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 05: PRIVATE CAPE WINELANDS TOUR – OVERLAND CAPE TOWN – STELLENBOSCH – FRANSCHHOEK (B/L/D)
Aged Oak Wine barrels in a cellar doing what it does best.
Without a doubt one of the most alluring activities in Cape Town is a **visit to the wine country** with its vast and verdant beauty, historical wine estates and towns and world-famous wines! On this day tour you will experience the **art of wine tasting** as well as learning a little about the colorful history of the region. **The Cape Wine route** is the first commercial wine route in the world and today it is regarded as one of the best. Lunch can be at Boschendal Wine Estate on the day. You will enjoy another wonderful wine tasting

whilst you get to know the **beautiful Winelands of Stellenbosch** and **Franschhoek**. A selection of top wine estates will be experienced in the Stellenbosch region. Return back to your hotel in Capetown.

DAY 06 - CAPETOWN – KRUGER NATIONAL PARK (B/D)
BY FLIGHT
Breakfast at the hotel and check out. You will be met by your driver for your private transfer to the airport for your flight to **Kruger MQP Airport** Arrive at **Kruger MQP** airport where you will be met by your driver for your private transfer to your hotel in Hazyview. Upon arrival at the hotel, check in. Lunch at the hotel (arrive time permitting). **Spend the balance of the day at leisure**. Dinner at the hotel. **Stay at Sabi River Sun for overnight**

DAY 07 – KRUGER – PANORAMA ROUTE - KARONGWE NATURE PARK – SUNSET GAME DRIVE (B/L/D)
Breakfast at the hotel and check out. Meet your driver-guide for your **Panorama Route tour** en route to your **lodge in the Karongwe reserve**. The Panorama Route Tour encompasses some spectacular scenery. Visit the **beautiful Berlin Falls** and **Lisbon Falls** Near Graskop there are numerous waterfalls that tumble down the mountains. Stop in **Graskop** and spend some time **browsing in local shops** or along the pavements where street vendors sell an amazing variety of goods from nuts and fruit to beaded necklaces and carved wooden animals. Lunch at a local restaurant.
Along the route **visit the famous Bourke's Luck Potholes**, deep cylindrical cavities formed by thousands of years of water erosion at the confluence of the **Blyde and Treur Rivers**. Continue along the edge of the escarpment to look out points that offer **magnificent views including God's Window, Wonderview** and the **Three Rondawels**. **Blyde River Canyon** for breathtaking views of the Blyde River Canyon and out over the endless Lowveld beyond. Proceed to your lodge and check in. Afternoon game drive which may continue into the early evening (arrival time depending). Dinner is served at the lodge. Stay at **Chisomo Safari Camp**

DAY 08 – MORNING AND SUNSET GAME DRIVE (THE HUNT OF THE BIG FIVE) (B/L/D)
Early morning wake up call. After tea, coffee and snacks your ranger will escort you to his **open safari vehicle for your morning game drive**. Return to the lodge and enjoy breakfast. **Day at leisure**. Lunch is served at the lodge. **Afternoon game drive that continues into the evening**. Dinner is served at the lodge. Stay at **Chisomo Safari Camp**.

DAY 09 – MORNING GAME DRIVE – FLIGHT TO JOHANNESBURG (B/D)
BY FLIGHT
Early morning wake up call. After tea, coffee and snacks your ranger will escorts you to his **open safari vehicle for your morning game drive**. Breakfast is served at the lodge. After breakfast check out, meet your driver and transfer to **Hoedspruit airport** for your flight to **Johannesburg** – flight not included.

Arrive at **OR Tambo (Johannesburg) International Airport**, where you will be met by a Royal African Discoveries representative who will assist you to your transfer. You will be met by your driver for your private transfer to the hotel. Upon arrival at the hotel, check in. Spend the balance of the day at leisure.
Dinner at the hotel. **Stay at Hilton Sandton**

DAY 10 – FULL PRIVATE TOUR IN JOHANNESBURG AND THE APARTHEID MUSEUM (B/L/D)
Breakfast at the hotel. You will be met by your driver and guide for a **private Full Day tour**. **Discover Johannesburg**, known as the 'City of Gold' and South Africa's economic heart. Travel through the bustling hub of the **Newtown district**, past Nelson Mandela Bridge towards Constitution Hill. Enjoy a **guided tour of Constitution Hill**. **Constitution Hill is a**

city precinct, anchored by the South African Constitutional Court – the highest court in the country on constitutional matters. Constitution Hill is also the site of Johannesburg's notorious Old Fort Prison Complex, where thousands of ordinary people were brutally punished before the dawn of democracy. Stroll through the **Apartheid Museum on this self-guided visit**. The Apartheid Museum is the story of the triumph of the human spirit over adversity. Beginning in 1948, the white elected National Party government initiated a process which turned over 20 million people into 2nd class citizens, damning them to a life of servitude, humiliation and abuse. Their liberation in 1994 with the election of Nelson Mandela, the prisoner who became president, is a climax in the saga of a nation's resistance, courage and fortitude. Lunch at a local restaurant.
Driving past famous landmarks such as the **FNB Soccer Stadium, Baragwanath Hospital** and the **massive Soweto Towers**. The important heritage sites in Soweto that commemorate the city's struggles during the apartheid era, and the popular streets and markets that showcase the vibrant, multi-cultural lifestyle of Soweto. Return to your hotel and spend the rest of the day at leisure. Dinner at the hotel. **Stay at Hilton Sandton**

DAY 11 -JOHANNESBURG – ZIMBABWE FLIGHT – SUNDOWNER CRUISE (B/D)
Breakfast at the hotel and check out. Breakfast at the hotel and check out. You will be met by your driver for your private **transfer to the airport for your flight to Victoria Falls** . Arrive at **Victoria Falls Airport** where you will be met and transferred to the hotel. Upon arrival at the hotel, check in. **Spend the balance of the day at leisure**. Lunch at the hotel. You will be met by your driver-guide in the hotel reception and depart on your scheduled **Sundowner Cruise on the Zambezi River**. Guests are met by staff from the **Cruise boat and driven to the jetty on the Zambezi River for boarding**. The Boat meanders slowly upstream along the length of the National Park looking for game on the way. A number of animals and a host of bird species can be viewed from comfortable chairs on cool wooden decks. Dinner at the hotel. **Stay at Elephant Hills Resort**

DAY 12 - VICTORIA FALLS (B/L/D)
Breakfast at the hotel. You will be met by your driver-guide in the hotel reception and depart on your **Seat-in-Coach Tour of the Falls**. Transfer to start your tour to discover how the Victoria Falls were formed and what local customs and traditions surround them. The Victoria Falls is the largest, probably the most beautiful and certainly the most majestic waterfall anywhere in the world. Lunch at the hotel.

In the afternoon, you will have free time to do your own tour option. You may join tours **Optionals 1. Flight of Angels- Helicopter ride 2. Bungy Jump – Zimbabwe -Zambia Bridge. 3. Zipline across Victoria Falls 3. Speed Thrill Boat -Victoria Falls or just enjoy an afternoon sunset at Elephant hills resort**. Dinner at the hotel **Stay at Elephant Hills Resort**

DAY 13 – VICTORIA FALLS - JOHANNESBURG (B/D)
BY FLIGHT
Breakfast at the hotel and check out. You will be met by your driver for your seat in coach **transfer to the airport for your flight to Johannesburg**. Arrive at **OR Tambo International Airport**, clear customs and proceed to the arrivals hall where you will be met by a Royal African Discoveries representative who will assist you to your coach. Transfer to your hotel and check in. Dinner at the hotel. **Stay at Southern Sun**

DAY 14 – JOHANNESBURG – AIRPORT (B/L)
Breakfast at the hotel and check out. You will be met by your driver and guide for a **Private Full Day Pretoria City Tour**. **Visit the Jacaranda city** and **take in Pretoria's past, present and future on this full day tour**. Sites include the **Voortrekker Monument** and the **Union Buildings**. Towering at 9 meters tall, a bronze sculpture of the late Nelson Mandela can also be seen at the Union Buildings. The statue was unveiled in December

2013 and the Union Buildings has since been declared a national heritage site. Lunch at a local restaurant. **Transfer to OR Tambo International Airport for your flight home.**


