DAY TO DAY ITINERARY

01MAR- D1/ MANILA/ COPENHAGEN (Inflight Meals)

Depart on Manila on prestigious airline for an overnight flight to Copenhagen, Denmark. Enjoy in-flight meals and entertainment on board.

02MAR- D2/ COPENHAGEN (Denmark) (D)

Arrival in Copenhagen, transfer from Copenhagen Airport to lunch, proceed to hotel, check-in. Dinner at hotel and overnight

03MAR-D3/COPENHAGEN

After heartwarming breakfast, take a luxury private coach for your guided city tour. Visit to the *Christianborg Palace* a place and government building on the islet of *Slotsholmen* in central Copenhagen. 06MAR-D6/ REYKJAVIK-THINGVELLIR- GOLDEN CIRCLE- VIK (BLD)

Today enjoy your full day guided tour starting with a visit to the visitor centre of the incredible tectonic rift at *Thingvellir National Park* then witness the three wonders of the famous *Iceland Golden Circle* on this day trip from Reykjavik. Travel by air-conditioned vehicle with an expert guide and learn the history and geology of each site. See

the breathtaking Gullfoss waterfall, the bubbling pools and Strokkur waterspout of *Geysir. A Langjokul Snowmobile tour* is arranged (solo riding) ,experience what it's like snowmobiling in the Land of Fire and Ice, you can dash over the smooth, snowy slopes of Iceland's second-largest glacier. Afterwards we travel to Vik, Vik í Myrdal, or just Vik, is the southernmost village on the Icelandic mainland, located 186 kilometres (110 miles) from the capital Reykjavík. Often visited by those travelling the popular sightseeing route along the South Coast, it is a wonderful place to stop, recharge, and if you are taking your time, rest for the night.

07MAR-D7/ VIK - JOKULSARLON(ICE CAVE TOUR) DYRHOLAEY -REYNISDRANGAR- VIK - NORTHERN LIGHTS HUNT BLD

After breakfast, In this beautiful, day get ready to explore *Jokulsarlon* and experience the glacial landscapes of Iceland up close on a 2.5 to 3-hour jeep tour to the natural ice cave of *Vatnajökull Glacier*. Marvel at the ice formations in a cave inside the largest glacier in Europe. Then onto *Dyrhólaey*, it is a Peninsula with120-metre promenade famed for its staggering views of Iceland's South Coast, as well as its historic lighthouse and wealth of birdlife. It is home to a rock arch of the same name.

Depart for *Reynisdrangar*, see the impressive rock formations situated near the shore of *Reynisfjara* beach by the coastal village Vík on the South Coast of Iceland. The formations are the remains of large and imposing sea cliffs, made up of basalt, that serve as a vital part of the area's allure; they shoot dramatically out of the ocean under the looming cliffs of *Mt. Reynisfjall*, making for a beautiful site, and have a folklore that is equally impressive.

After your dinner, experience a *Private Northern Lights Hunting together* with your expert local guide.

08MAR-D8 - VIK- SKOGAR - SELJALANDFOSS- REYKJAVIK (BLD)

After breakfast we drive to *skogafoss*, one of Iceland's biggest and most beautiful waterfalls with an astounding width of 25 meters (82 feet) and a drop of 60 meters (197 feet) (Photostop), then we drive to Seljalandsfoss, waterfall along Iceland's southern coast is fed by melting water from the famed glacier- capped *Eyjafjallajokull volcano*. This powerful waterfall cascades into a pretty meadow. However, the path that runs behind the curtain of water is the main attraction. There you can enjoy a truly unique viewpoint of the waterfall. Then we drive back to Reykjavik, upon arrival proceed to city tour including, *Perlan View Stop, Hodi House*, the Harpa Concert Hall, Tjornin lake and Laugavegur .Afterwards proceed to your hotel for check in , dinner and overnight.

09MAR- D9 REYKJAVIK- GRINDAVIK-REYKJAVIK (BLD)

After breakfast, enjoy the relaxing day to transfer you to Blue Lagoon and experience the natural geothermal spa surrounded by Lava Field and black sandy beaches. Afternoon is free time on your own pace. *BLUE LAGOON -comfort package including entrance ticket,

Silica Mud Mask, Use of towel, 1 Drink of your choice, Algae Mask** Afterwards proceed back to hotel for dinner and overnight,

10MAR- D10- REYKJAVIK - KEFLAVIK / STOCKHOLM (Sweden) (BD)

Breakfast and transfer to the airport for your flight to Stockholm, Sweden Upon arrival in Stockholm, delight in a sightseeing tour in the afternoon including visit to Drottingholmslott, Explore Drottningholm Palace, Sweden's best preserved private residence of the Swedish royal family .Discover the 17th century palace known for its one-of-akind exterior and exquisite interior. Overview of this district with a relaxed atmosphere and typical architecture!

11MAR-D11- STOCKHOLM - - FERRY BOAT TO HELSINKI - OVERNIGHT IN A FERRY B/L/Dinner on board

After breakfast, we check out, today we will have a city tour around Stockholm including Entrance to Vasa Museum to see the remaining solid 17th ice century ship in the world, photo stop at *Fjallgatan*, *Gamla stan, panoramic view of Royal Palace, Old Town, Gustav Adolf Square and Concert Hall*, *skansen*, *Abba and Nordic museums*. Mid-afternoon we leave for the pier to embark on the Tallink Silja Line overnight ferry bound for Helsinki.
