

MARIAN PILGRIMAGE: JUBILLEE YEAR PORTUGAL - SPAIN - FRANCE - ITALY MAY 21 - 10 JUN 2025

MAY 21/DAY 1 - MANILA - AIRPORT TERMINAL 3

Inflight Meals Meet and greet in NAIA 1 at 5 o'clock in the afternoon, prepare for check in at 7pm, proceed to immigration and prepare for flight bound to Lisbon Portugal

MAY 22/DAY-2: LISBON - SANTAREM - FATIMA

(L/D) Arrival Lisbon International Airport. Meet and assist with our guide. We will drive to city center of Lisbon for sightseeing - see the Tagus River, Marques de Pombal Square, and Liberdade Avenue, pass by Belem Palace, official residence of the President of Portugal. Stop at Belem Tower – icon of the Age of Discovery and the Monument of the Discoveries. Close by is Jeronimos Monastery, magnificent example of the Manueline style. See the Baixa, Praca do Comer-cio and the Suspension Bridge. Lastly, see St. Anthony's Church. On the way to Fatima, we will visit Santarém, which is a city and municipality located in the district of Santarém in Portugal. The Eucharistic miracle of Santarém, together with that of Lanciano, is considered among the most important Eucharistic miracles. Proceed to Fatima for some free time for private devotion. You may explore the Sanctuary and the Great White Basili-ca and maybe, join the candlelight procession in the evening.

MAY 23/ DAY-3: FATIMA

(B/L/D)Have your breakfast inside the hotel. Start the day with visiting the following places: the Basilica where the tombs of Lucia, Francisco, and Jacinta is located; the Chapel of the Apparitions the place where Our Lady appeared; the church of the Holy Trinity; the exposition "Fatima Light and Peace" where are the offers left by the pilgrims. Later visit Aljustrel, the village where the shepherds were born. Continue to Valinhos and visit the Stations of the Cross and the Calvary, the site of Our Lady's 4th apparition and the place where the children received the first and third visit of the "Angel of Peace". After the visit proceed to the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Ortiga and to the Parish Church. The afternoon is free for personal devotions. At the end of the day, return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

MAY 24/ DAY-4 FATIMA - SALAMANCA - MADRID

Have your breakfast inside the hotel. After breakfast we board our coach and motor across the Portuguese-Spanish border to the city of Salamanca, where we visit the Basilica de Nuestra Senora de Penafrancia and the great University of Salamanca, the oldest university in Spain and one of the oldest in Europe. We celebrate mass today at the Basilica. The city lies on a plateau by the Tormes river, which is crossed by a bridge 500 ft long built on 26 arches, fifteen of which are of Roman origin, while the remainder date from the 16th century. Salamanca has been declared a "World Heritage Site" by UNESCO. Lunch and free time. Then, proceed to Madrid. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel for check in and resting. Dinner and overnight will be in the hotel.

MAY 25/DAY-5 MADRID

(B/L/D) Have your breakfast inside the hotel. Visit the Royal Palace and the Almudena's Cathedral, Madrid's Cathedral, and one of the city's most beautiful churches. The Royal Palace of Madrid is the official residence of the Spanish royalfamily at the city of Madrid, although now used only for state ceremonies. The palace has 135,000 m² of floor space and contains 3,418 rooms. It is the largest functioning royal palace and the largest by floor area in Europe, Almudena Cathedral is a Catholic church in Madrid. Spain. It is the seat of the Roman CatholicArchdiocese of Madrid. The cathedral was consecrated by Pope John Paul II in 1993. Lunch will be in local restaurant. Free time for shopping. Transfer to hotel for resting. Dinner and overnight will be in the hotel.

MAY 26/DAY-6 MADRID - ZARAGOZA

Have your breakfast inside the hotel. Today we will head to Zaragoza. Visit the basilica

of "Our Lady of the Pillar", where the virgin Mary appeared miraculously to Saint James the Great in the first century, standing on a pillar. Free time for souvenir shopping in the afternoon. Transfer to hotel for check in. Dinner and accommodation will be in the hotel.

MAY 27 / DAY-7 ZARAGOZA - MONTSERRAT - BARCELONA (B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure for Barcelona. On the way, visit to the Montserrat Monastery to see the famous 12th century Romanesque carv-ing of Virgen Moreneta, the Black Virgin. Lunch will be in local restaurant. Afterwards, proceed to Barcelona. Upon arrival, we will visit Sagrada Familia with entrane and tour inside. The Basílica i Temple Expiatori de la Sagrada Família, also known as the Sagrada Família, is a large unfinished minor basilica in the Eixample district of Barcelona, Catalonia, Spain, and is currently the largest unfinished Roman Catholic church. Dinner will be in local restaurant. Transfer to hotel and accommodation.

MAY 28 / DAY-8 BARCELONA - LOURDES (B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel and check out from the hotel. Today, we will depart to Lourdes which is a town in southwestern France, in the foothills of the Pyrenees mountains. It's known for the Sanctuaires Notre-Dame de Lourdes, or the Domain, a major Catholic pilgrimage site. Each year, millions visit the Grotto of Massabielle (Grotto of the Apparitions) where, in 1858, the Virgin Mary is said to have appeared to a local woman. In the grotto, pilgrims can drink or bathe in water flowing from a spring. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel for check in and resting. Free praying activities. Dinner and accommodation will be in the hotel.

MAY 29/ DAY-9 LOURDES

The day is free for private devotion. You may wish to go to the Sanctuary to visit the Underground Basilica, walk the Station of the Cross, take the Holy Bath, drink the water or wash your face in the Grotto, or participate in the veneration of the sick pilgrim. In the evening, join the emotive candlelight procession.

MAY 30/ DAY-10 LOURDES - PARIS VIA TGV BULLET TRAIN

Breakfast at the hotel and departure for Paris. Upon arrival, half day guided city tour of Paris. Visit Chapel of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal, see the Eiffel Tower, Champs Elysees, and the Arc de Triomphe, Place de la Concorde, Les Invalides, and the Louvre Museum. Afterwards, free time. Transfer to hotel and resting. Dinner and accommodation will be in the hotel.

MAY 31/DAY-11 PARIS

Breakfast at the hotel and transfer to your full day guided city tour of Paris. Paris, the cosmopolitan capital of France, is one of Europe's largest cities, with 2.2 million people living in the dense, central city and almost 12 million people living in the whole metropolitan area. Located in the north of France on the river Seine, Paris has the welldeserved reputation of being the most beautiful and romantic of all cities, brimming with historic associations and remaining vastly influential in the realms of culture, art, fashion, food and design. Visit Chapel of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal. Afternoon, sightseeing river cruise aboard Bateaux Mouches Cruise is included. Free time for your own. Dinner then continues to hotel for overnight.

JUNE 01/ DAY-12 PARIS - LYON

(B/L/D)After breakfast, check out from the hotel. Departure for Lyon. Upon arrival, we will have lunch in local restaurant. Afterwards, we will have walking city tour in Lyon. Lyon, the capital city in France's Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes region, sits at the junction of the Rhône and Saône rivers. Its center reflects 2,000 years of history from the Roman Amphithéâtre des Trois Gaules, medieval and Renaissance architecture in Vieux (Old) Lyon, to the modern Confluence district on Presqu'île peninsula. Traboules, covered passageways between buildings, connect Vieux Lyon and La Croix-Rousse hill. Dinner and accommodation will be in the hotel.

JUNE 02/DAY-13 LYON - TURIN - MILAN

Breakfast inside the hotel. Proceed to Turin. Upon arrival, we will have full day Turin city tour. Turin is the capital city of Piedmont in northern Italy, known for its refined architecture and cuisine. The Alps rise to the northwest of the city. Stately baroque buildings and old cafes line Turin's boulevards and grand squares such as Piazza Castello and Piazza San Carlo. Nearby is the soaring spire of the Mole Antonelliana, a 19th-century tower housing the interactive National Cinema Museum. Visit to St. John the Baptist Basilica to view the replica of the Holy Shroud of Turin, see the Basilica of Superga, Casa Della Vittoria, Grattacielo IntesaSanpaolo and Juventus Stadium. Free time. Afterwards, proceed to Milan, Upon arrival, check in the hotel and resting, Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

JUNE 03/DAY-14 MILAN

After breakfast, we will discover Milan, a metropolis in Italy's northern Lombardy restaurant. After lunch, Proceed to Manopello to visit Santuario del Volto Santo. Celebrate Thanksgiving Mass at the old Capuchin Monastery and see miraculous image of Christ's face on a veil, the "veronica" (true icon) in the Santuario Del Volto Santo. The image shows a male face with long hair and a beard parted in bands. JUNE 04/ DAY-15 MILAN - PISA - FLORENCE

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Firstly, we will see the amazing Lean-ing Tower and the nearby Cathedral then proceed to Florence. Upon arrival, start city tour in Florence which is capital of Italy's Tuscany region, is home to many masterpieces of Renaissance art and architecture. One of its most iconic sights is the Duomo, a cathedral with a terracotta-tiled dome engineered by Brunelleschi and a bell tower by Giotto. The Galleria dell'Accademia displays Michelangelo's "David" sculpture. The Uffizi Gallery exhibits Botticelli's "The Birth of Venus" and da Vinci's "Annunciation. See the Renaissance treasures of the city. Visit the magnificent Santa Maria del Fiore, Giotto's Bell Tower, the Baptistry's Gate of Paradise and the sculpture studded Signoria Square. Dinner and overnight will be in the hotel.

JUNE 05/ DAY-16 FLORENCE - ASSISI - MANOPELLO - SAN GIOVANNI (B/L/D)

After breakfast, Departure for Assisi. Upon arrival, we will have short city tour in Assisi. Assisi the hometown of the Beloved St. Francis. See the Basilica of St. Francis and the Basilica of Santa Maria Degli Angeli. Free time. Lunch will be in local restaurant. After lunch, Proceed to Manopello to visit Santuario del VoltSanto.
